THE 2019-2020 SEASON ...before the pandemic

The 2019-2020 Season began with a stunning concert led by Maestro Rhodes and featured World Class Soprano OTHALIE GRAHAM.

The Season continued by featuring TSO Principal Flutist, NANCY STAGNITTA, performing David Amram's Giants of the Night, a jazz inspired tribute to Charlie Parker, Jack Kerouac and Dizzy Gillespie.

January's concert saw the return of outstanding young professionals, and TSO Civic ensemble alumni, Ivan Suminski, Kyle Stachnik and Joe Skerik, the VIRIDIAN STRINGS.

Featuring indie rock band THE ACCIDENTALS, 2019's *Home for the Holidays* was a hit, attracting hundreds of new audience members to the TSO, and delighting a new generation of fans.

Reinventing the TSO Season

In March of 2020, the TSO began the process of radically reinventing and creatively reimagining outreach to safely engage and entertain our community. After much consultation with community focus groups and arts leaders, we instituted a three-pronged approach to realizing our mission: safe and distanced live performance, online educational outreach, and virtual concerts.

Each of these adaptations was focused on safety for both our musicians and audience, community engagement with outreach to new audiences and providing a consistent and meaningful educational experience through our Civic Programs.

Increased virtual engagement on multiple online platforms provided access to thousands of new listeners, expanding the reach of TSO's performances, while continuing to connect with existing patrons and supporters.

"The TSO Civic program is unique in our community and has made available a vibrant, multi-age performing string orchestra program for amateur musicians since 2004.

Re-inventing the live orchestra experience in a virtual setting is the biggest challenge the Civic program has faced.

Many of our adult Civic participants are retired and isolated in their homes during the pandemic.








The quickly changing public health landscape required the TSO to adopt an innovative new approach to sustainability. Our exciting new "Play a Part" MEMBERSHIP MODEL combined the dedication of our season ticket holders with the strength of our annual donor campaign. Propelled by an \$80,000 matching grant from an anonymous benefactor, and support from our new members, the TSO was able to continue to provide vibrant arts and education programs to our community during the global pandemic shutdown.

TSO Membership Levels

FRIEND \$100 - 419/year

Recognition in our programs and a 10% discount on TSO merchandise.

APPLAUSE \$35/monthly subscription (\$420/yr)

Equivalent to our former average household season ticket price, donations at this level provide a steady stream of support for our year long education programs, and support the ongoing operations of the Symphony. In addition to the benefits of the previous level, patrons at this level will receive access to online chamber concerts and other premium digital content.

OVATION \$1,000 - \$2,499/year

Provides funding for hiring one TSO musician for one concert weekend, and in addition to the benefits of the previous level will provide the donor with early access to concert tickets for our Pops concerts.

STANDING OVATION \$2,500 - \$4,999/year

A gift at this level will fund one of the new small chamber or pop-up concerts this season, and in addition to the benefits of the previous level will provide the donor with reserved seating at our live chamber concerts.

BRAVO \$5,000 - \$9,999/year

A gift at this level will fund the location for one Symphony Pops concert, or support the season salary of one of our principal musicians. In addition to the benefits of the previous level, Bravo members will be invited to an exclusive live VIP event featuring Maestro Kevin Rhodes.

BRAVISSIMO \$10,000+/year

A gift of \$10,000 or more would join a legacy of extraordinary support that has built this orchestra into one of the cultural jewels of this region. Not only does this gift support the orchestra, but through that generosity lifts all of Northern Michigan as a cultural destination, ensuring its vibrancy and growing momentum as one of the great places to live in the U.S.

Gifts at any level are fully tax deductible. All pledges can be billed monthly.

MUSICIAN SUPPORT FUND








Grants for the Last Five Seasons
